Minimal audio production events may use smaller control positions, reducing capacity by 19 or 16 seats. The venue will automatically hold the full position until full production specifications are known.

Projectors can either be rigged for a full house, or placed on the Level 2 balcony depending on the expected attendance. There is restricted viewing for seats on Level 2 and 3 closest to stage when AV screens are in place.

There are two camera tripod positions to either side of the auditorium, and one behind the audio control position. It is also possible to set up tripods in standing room to the rear of Level 1 and on upper levels.

Functions

Cocktails for up to 600 can be held between the Entry Lobby and mezzanine bar on Level 1 without splitting the function. The two spaces are joined by a grand marble staircase, which is conducive to movement between levels. Using two levels also opens opportunities for theming and creativity, such as casinos or chill-out areas.
